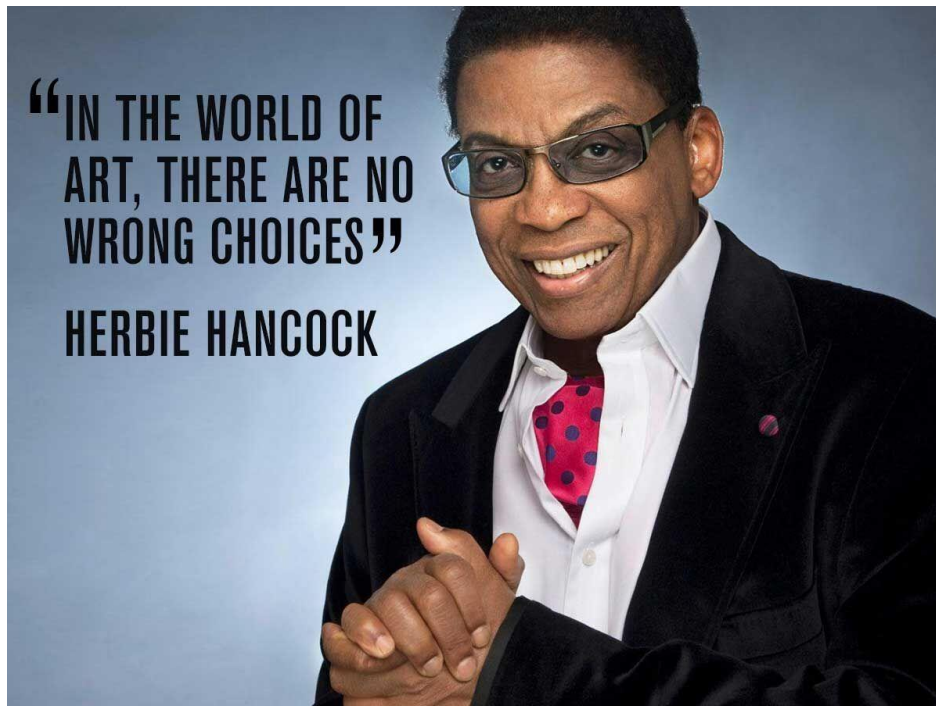


FAMOUS JAZZMAN IN PRAGUE

Herbie Hancock (*April 12, 1940) is a famous American jazz pianist from Chicago.

In 1951, when he is only 11 years old, he plays a Mozart's piano concerto¹ with the Chicago Symphony Orchestra. He is a **child genius**.



As an adult, Herbie becomes² a legendary³ jazz pianist and composer⁴. He also wins an Oscar for his music for the film *Round Midnight*, and he has got fourteen **Grammy Awards**.

Herbie is also Professor of Poetry⁵ at Harvard University, **as well as** a member of the **American Academy**

of Arts and Sciences.

Herbie Hancock is visiting Prague now. This Saturday, on the 9th of November, he has a concert at O2 Universum in Prague, the new modern sports and cultural centre.
